TERRAMAR BEACH COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ALL HOMES

WHEREAS, the Terramar Beach Community Improvement Association (the "Association"), a Texas non-profit corporation, is the governing entity for the Terramar Beach subdivision, as the same is subject to certain dedications, covenants, and restrictions recorded in the Galveston County Real Property Records;

WHEREAS, Texas Property Code Section 204.010(6) provides that an Association's Board may "regulate the use, maintenance, repair, replacement, modification, and appearance of the subdivision" and;

WHEREAS, the Association's Board of Directors desires to adopt certain rules and regulations pertaining to the use and appearance of the subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, in accordance with the foregoing, the Association acting through its Board of Directors hereby adopts, establishes, and imposes the following Rules and Regulations for Terramar Beach which shall become effective upon the recording of this document in the Galveston County Real Property Records. All owners and any guests are to adhere to these Rules and Regulations to maintain the peaceful enjoyment by all homeowners and guests in the community:

1. Trash must be bagged and TIGHTLY secured with a twist tie or knot to ensure that no trash can blow out of the trash cart. Each home must maintain adequate carts to ensure that carts accommodate trash for the entire week for Monday trash pickup. If a home has more trash than can be secured in cart for pickup day, homeowner must arrange for additional pickups with an independent source or acquire more trash carts from the City of Galveston. All carts need to be removed from the street on the same day as trash pickup. Please see the City of Galveston Ordinance concerning trash pickup:

"All receptacles shall be set out for collection prior to 6:30a.m. on the regular day of collection (Monday for Terramar Beach) whether for refuse or for recyclable material, but no sooner than 5:00p.m. of the day prior to collection. Where possible, as determined by the director of municipal utilities or his designee, all receptacles shall be returned to private property, secured and screened from view as soon as practicable after servicing, but, in no case later than 10:00p.m. of the day of service. The director of municipal utilities may allow receptacles to remain in alleys when appropriate.

2. All vehicles which are parked in a street must be parked in such a manner as not to impede traffic or emergency vehicles AT ANY TIME. When parked in the street, no vehicles can park opposite of or side-by-side with a vehicle which would limit the movement of regular traffic flow. Driveways must be full before vehicles can be parked in the street in the manner described herein. No vehicle which is parked in a street may block any part of a neighboring driveway.

- 3. All owners must provide a 24/7 contact person who is required to be available to address problems such as parking, trash, trespassing, animal issues and noise issues. The name and phone number of this individual for each house will be provided to the Association via the community manager: Lisa Porter lisap@kpmtx.com. Please send the information to Lisa upon receipt of these Rules and Regulations.
- 4. Noise/Lights Out -out of respect for neighbors, all residents and their guests will observe the City Noise Ordinance of the City of Galveston which states:

"The City of Galveston's municipal code provides for permissible sound levels within city limits. City Code Section 24-2 limits weighted decibels produced by any activity or sound source to the following levels:

DAYTIME HOURS – 7am to 10pm: dB(A) shall be 75; NIGHTTIME HOURS – 10pm to 7am: dB(A) shall be seventy (70).

These Rules may be modified as needed by the Association's Board of Directors.

Nothing herein is intended to alter, modify or amend the Restrictions, except as specifically provided hereinabove.
