TERRAMAR BEACH COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE POLICY

THE STATE OF TEXAS §
COUNTY OF GALVESTON §

WHEREAS, the property encumbered by this Architectural Control Committee ("ACC") Policy (the "Policy") is that property restricted by the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for TERRAMAR BEACH COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION (the "Association"), recorded in the Official Public Records of Galveston County, Texas, as same has been or may be amended from time to time (the "Declaration"), and any other property which has been or may be subsequently annexed thereto and made subject to the authority of the "Association"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Dedicatory Instruments governing the Property or State Code, the Association is vested with the authority to adopt policies, rules and/or guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Association (the "Board") has determined that, in order to provide guidance regarding Architectural Controls authorized by Texas Code Sections 202, 204 and/or 209 (the "Code"), it is appropriate for the Association to adopt an ACC Policy for the properties under the jurisdiction of the Association; and

WHEREAS, any reference made herein to approval by the ACC means prior written approval by the ACC for the Association; and

WHEREAS reference is hereby made to the Declaration for all purposes, and any and all capitalized terms used herein shall have the meaning set forth in the Declaration, unless otherwise specified in this Policy.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted in the Code, the Board hereby adopts this Policy which shall run with the land and be binding on all Owners and Lots within the Property. The provisions of this Policy are in addition to any other applicable guidelines, rules, or policies. In the event of a conflict between the terms of this Policy and any previously adopted guidelines, rules, and/or policies addressing security measures, this Policy will control.

I. **DEFINITIONS**

For purposes of this Policy "Improvement, Enhancements, Change or Modification" shall mean:

Any change to the exterior of the home, yard, structures, or fence that is visible from the street or a neighboring property. Examples could include, but are not limited to:

Painting	Fencing	Siding	Walkways and Driveways
Flagpole	Solar Panels	Generators	Pools and Spas
Staircase	Patios	Pergolas	Storage Building

A. ACC Approval

Any "Improvement, Enhancement, Change or Modification" of any nature shall require approval from the ACC. A homeowner is required to submit an ACC REQUEST FORM (see the attached Example) to the ACC requesting approval prior to commencement of any work.

The specifications should be included with the ACC REQUEST FORM. The completed ACC REQUEST FORM should be submitted directly to management company.

B. Architectural Control Committee

The Architectural Control Committee (the "ACC") will consist of not less than one person and not more than 4 persons who are appointed by the Association's Board of Directors. Member(s) of the committee will serve until replaced by the Association's Board of Directors. Per State Code, a person may not serve on the ACC if they are:

A current board member
 A current board member's spouse; or
 A person residing in a current board member's household

The ACC Committee is charged with following the Rules and Restrictions detailed in the Association's Deed Restrictions, this policy, and local and state regulations.

C. **Appeal of ACC Decision**

On occasion the ACC may decline a homeowner's ACC Request or grant a conditional approval. A homeowner may appeal the denial or conditional approval to the Association's Board. To file an appeal, the homeowner must provide the management company with written notices of their request to appeal the ACC decision. The notice should include a copy of the original ACC Request Form. Upon receipt of the written notice from a homeowner, the Board will:

Hold a hearing, either in person, or via a video conference call, within 30-days from receipt of the notice.

Provide the homeowner with the date, time, and location of the hearing; not less than 10days before the hearing.

Provide the homeowner an opportunity to discuss the issues, verify facts, and resolve the denial or conditional approval.

The Board may affirm, modify, or reverse, in whole or in part, any decision of the ACC.
